- To unite key stakeholders, driving standardization efforts and advancing business automation, while also piloting development initiatives to showcase practical utility.

# Current Tasks



- >> The Working Group has begun work on a [pilot project focused on Standardized Web3 Cross-Industry Interoperable Communication Solution for Electronic Vehicle Registration, Titling, and Liens](#), utilizing verifiable data from the vehicle and the digital identity infrastructure to automate and minimize errors in the process, which currently is very manual and prone to mistakes and delays. The Working Group is finalizing the program flow for the pilot as a first step, which is needed to begin developing the user journeys, user stories, schemas, and screen designs.
